CenterLink: The Community of LGBTQ+ Centers

A nonprofit, member-based association of LGBTQ+ centers and other LGBTQ+ organizations serving their local and regional communities. Use this website to search for local LGBTQ+ Centers ranging from health and wellness centers to youth mentorship and social programs, as well as live events searchable by area.

Give Us the Floor

This free mobile app provides a safe and anonymous community where 2SLGBTQIA+ youth ages 13 to 24 support each other without fear of stigma, taboo, or shame. Youth can access small, facilitated groups or community-wide discussion channels covering topics ranging from serious, such as mental health and discrimination, to lighter, such as pets and memes.

Navigating Personal Safety While Taking Action as an LGBTQ+ Young Person

This guide developed by The Trevor Project provides practical advice and support for LGBTQ+ youth who want to participate in activism while prioritizing their personal safety. It also recognizes the unique risks LGBTQ+ young people may face and offers strategies to help them make informed decisions.

Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays (PFLAG) Los Angeles

The PFLAG LA chapter offers educational materials, local resources and three monthly, virtual support meetings for family members and loved ones of LGBTQ+ folks, including one in Spanish. Additionally, <u>PFLAG Connects:</u> <u>Communities</u> offers safe, moderated virtual support groups where people with shared experiences can connect monthly. Current communities gather people of Latinx, Black/African American, and AAPI backgrounds, as well as military families, grandparents, and gender spectrum parents.

The California LGBTQ Health and Human Services Network

A resource hub, including relevant news and policy updates, local community programs, fact sheets, legal programs, and more to support and protect LGBTQ+ folks during these difficult and stressful times. Resources are organized and available by county/regions within California.
